About the Project

The National Independent Visitor Network (NIVN) is a good practice and campaign network for Independent Visitor services and the children and young people they support, in England and Wales. We plan to create a short animation to spread the work to change-makers like the government, Ofsted and local authorities, about the importance of IV to thousands of children and young people.

Children and young people who are looked after and aged 10+ with an interest in animation and cartooning are invited to commit to six, one-hour workshops. The workshops will be led by a professional cartoonist and filmmaker and the NIVN Team Manager and Project Worker. The NIVN Project Team are Barnardo's employees who have completed mandatory safeguarding training and have enhanced DBS checks in place.

Commitment level and IT requirement

Workshops will take place on Zoom and young people will need access to a computer. Links with passcodes will be sent ahead of the workshops and require pre-registration.

Data Protection: What is data and how will you use my data?

To join the animation project, the NIVN Project Team will need to collect and safely save some personal information about the children and young people taking part. This is called 'data'. At the end of this form we will ask you for your agreement, or consent, to collect and save this data. If there is any data you do not wish to share with us, you do not have to.

Barnardo's respects your privacy and is committed to protecting your personal data. We will use your data to keep in contact with you and keep a record of communications with you. No personal data will be shared outside of the animation workshop without your consent. You can read our full privacy notice at <https://www.barnardos.org.uk/privacy-notice>.

Data privacy is very important to Barnardo's, the data collected is stored securely and adheres to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018. We will not disclose or share personal information supplied by you without your consent, unless we are required to do so by law or we believe there is a risk of harm. The personal data that is collected about you will be kept until the end of March 2022 and then deleted.

Barnardo's and the Local Authority who look after you are Joint Data Controllers and therefore both organisations are responsible for your data.

You can request to see information that is held about you. This is called a Subject Access Request (SAR).
